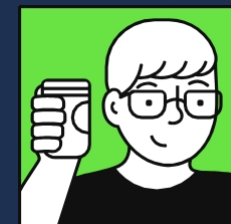

UFR (Unité de Formation et de Recherche): This Teaching and Research Unit, also known as a faculty. This refers to each of the “components” of the university (equivalent of faculty), and each of them encompasses several discipline departments.

CM (Cours Magistral): Lecture

TD: (Travaux Dirigés): Tutorials

TP: (Travaux Pratiques): Practical exercises

UE: (Unité d'Enseignement): Teaching unit

ECTS: European Credit Transfer System

These credits are awarded upon successful completion of a teaching unit, enable the recognition of studies and qualifications across Europe, and promote student mobility.

ECUE: (éléments constitutifs d'unités d'enseignement): Building blocks of teaching unit

LMD: (Licence, Master, Doctorat): bachelor's degree, master's degree, doctorate

EDT: (Emploi Du Temps) : Timetable

MCC: (Modalités de Contrôle des Connaissances) : Knowledge assessment modalities

Partiels: (Examens de fin de semestre) : End of term exams

CLES: (certificat de compétences en langues de l'enseignement supérieur): Higher education languages skills certificate

CLER: (Centre de langues étrangères et régionale): Foreign and regional languages center

PIX: Digital and IT skills certification

ENT: (Environnement numérique de travail): Digital working space

Moodle: The University of Montpellier Paul-Valéry's learning platform, where you can access course materials, online courses, tutorials, forums, calendars and more

REGISTER

**I REGISTER, I LOG IN**

The day after you have completed your administrative registration, you must activate your ENT (Digital working space) account.

PEDAGOGIC REGISTRATION

This refers to enrolment for courses and exams (knowledge assessment). It takes place after administrative registration, as soon as September, from your ENT. In case of any issue, get in touch with your faculty/UFR or your Institute.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

Pedagogic registration is mandatory, if you do not complete it, you will not be able to sit your exams. As a scholarship student, you risk losing your entitlement to the higher education grant for the current academic year. Go to your ENT, under the 'Scolarité et examens' tab.

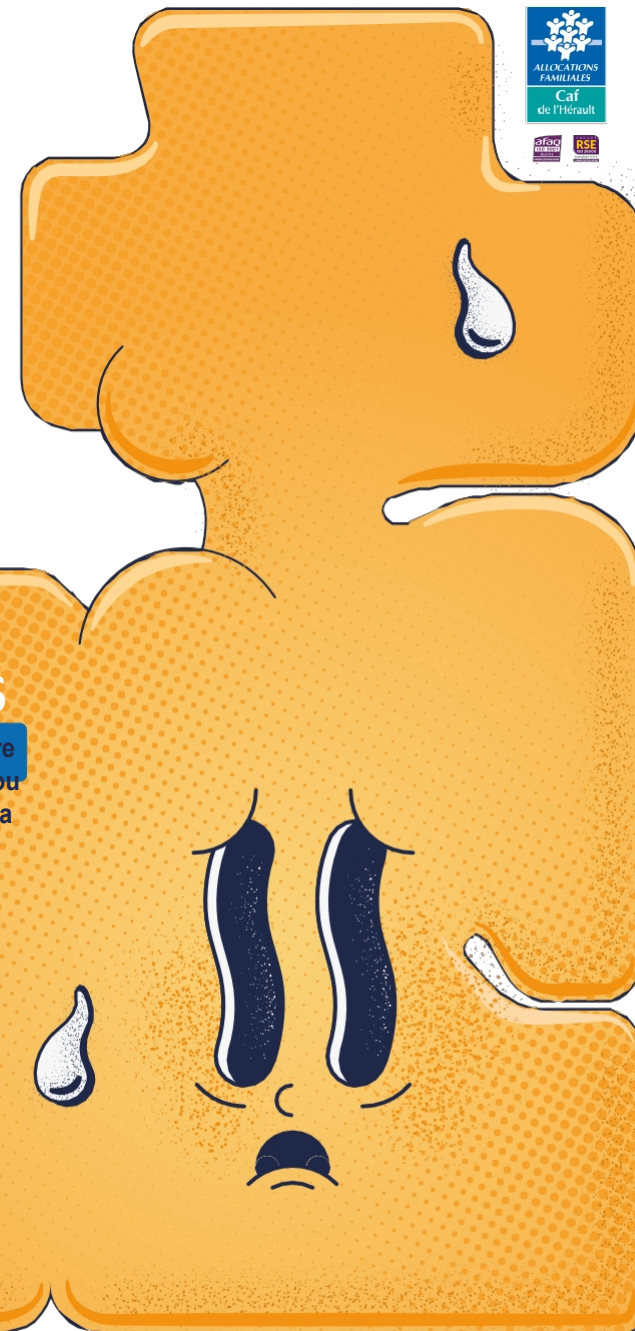

IN ALL UNIVERSITY LIBRARIES, A WIDE RANGE OF SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE TO YOU!

- **Borrow** (no registration required, just show your student card): books, textbooks, language learning materials, journals and magazines, DVDs, comics, etc.
Undergraduate and postgraduate students: 10 items for 21 days. Items can be returned to any library in the network.
Reserve items that are already on loan. You can request items to be transferred from other libraries in Montpellier to the one of your choice.
- **Borrow IT equipment** (for use on-site or at home): computers, tablets, webcams, headsets, video projectors, etc.
- **Print, photocopy, scan and bind** your documents.
- **Book a room equipped with a home cinema system.**
- **Book and access the Ciné-Musique room, which is equipped with a piano.**
- **Book a place in the 'Visual Arts' room**, dedicated to artistic practice.
- **Book group study rooms** and work on your own laptop (power sockets, Wi-Fi) or on a library computer.

DID YOU KNOW?

Within the Atrium Library, 37 study rooms (seating 2, 4, 6 and 10 people) are available to the university community by booking via the Affluences app.

On the first floor of the Atrium Library, 10 study rooms (seating 2, 4 and 6 people) are available without booking for registered users, from 8.30 am to 10.30 pm.

A UNIVERSITY SPREAD ACROSS FIVE CAMUSES

The Paul-Valéry site (Route de Mende, Montpellier) is the University's main campus. Designated as 'remarkable contemporary architecture', the campus covers 10.5 hectares.

The Boutonnet site (8, rue de l'École normale, Montpellier). Formerly Montpellier's School of Chemistry, since the start of the 2021 academic year it has been home to some of the University's teaching programmes and inter-university services.

The Saint-Charles site (rue du professeur Henri-Serre, Montpellier), situated in the city centre, houses research activities and related courses (Master's and PhD programmes) in listed buildings.

The Saint-Louis site (11, rue Saint Louis, Montpellier), situated in the city centre, is primarily home to the University Diploma in Music Therapy and courses for the Master's in Performing Arts Creation.

The Centre Du-Guesclin (3, allées Doyen-Nerson, Béziers) has been the Béziers branch of the University of Montpellier Paul-Valéry since 1996.

Musée des Moulages

A collection listed as a Historic Monument

The Musée des Moulages, a university museum, serves as an educational and scientific resource. It stands as both a historical testament to **the teaching of archaeology and ancient and medieval art since the late 19th century**, and a key player in the cultural life of the University of Montpellier Paul-Valéry, thanks to the temporary exhibitions and cultural and scientific events regularly held there.

FURTHER TRAINING

CERTIFICATIONS, LANGUAGES AND IT

The university offers all its students a state-recognised qualification (CLES) which certifies their level of proficiency in foreign languages, as well as training in IT and digital tools – compulsory in the first year and optional in the second and third years – to prepare students for the Pix certification. It also provides its students with a foreign and regional language learning centre (CLER) which is open to all.

CERTIFICATE OF LANGUAGE COMPETENCE IN HIGHER EDUCATION (CLES)

The CLES is a qualification accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Space. It certifies candidates' ability to use a modern language for the purposes of oral and written communication.

Open to all University students, as well as external candidates, it is available at three standard reference levels: CLES B1, CLES B2 and CLES C1. It assesses five skills: listening comprehension, reading comprehension, written production, spoken production and oral interaction, depending on the level of the CLES certificate taken.

The CLES is available in seven languages: German, English, Chinese, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese and Russian.

CERTIFICATE IN DIGITAL AND IT SKILLS (PIX)

All first-year undergraduate students (L1) undertake compulsory training in IT tools and their applications.

This enables them to acquire or enhance digital skills that are useful both for their studies and for personal or professional activities. A range of optional modules allows second- and third-year students (L2–L3) to supplement their training in this area. These courses are aligned with the national reference framework for digital skills. Paul-Valéry University is accredited as a 'Pix Certification Centre', which enables it to offer free national certification sessions to its students on initial training programmes.

Good to know

Authorisation for absence due to menstrual problems entitles you to 10 days' absence per year (maximum 2 days per month) in the event of painful or debilitating periods.

Another scheme, known as 'Absence Day Credits', is designed to address difficulties in accessing healthcare and prevent the overburdening of GP surgeries with minor medical issues. Any student enrolled on an initial training programme is entitled to 4 days' absence per year, with no supporting documentation required.

These absences must be reported via the digital learning platform (ENT) and will be recognised as justified for lectures, assessments and exams.

WELLBEING CENTRE

Wellbeing is a key factor in success. This centre's remit is to combat isolation by fostering social connections, to support students in learning techniques to manage their stress, to provide information on support services and resources, and to promote wellbeing...
