## ASSISTANCE TO PERSONS

### ABSOLUTE EMERGENCY

(unconscious victim,  
cardiac arrest, hemorrhage...)

- Call the **SAMU**, dial: **15**
- Notify the University security service
- Perform first aid procedures

### RELATIVE EMERGENCY

(fainting, conscious victim...)

- Call the **University security service**
- Perform first aid procedures

## FIRE

### IN THE EVENT OF ABNORMAL SMOKE, SMELL OF BURNING

- Evacuate the building when you hear the fire alarm
- Go to the nearest exit
- Do not use the lift
- If there is smoke, crouch down to move forward
- Go to the designated assembly point
- Call 18 and campus security

# SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

In case of exceptional situations, the alert is triggered by voice message, SMS or email from the management.

## Evacuate

In the event of a bomb or earthquake alert

Close the windows

2



Calmly evacuate the building

3



Go to the designated assembly point

## Seek shelter

In the event of floods or storms



Go to the nearest building



Close doors, windows and shutters



Wait for the end of the alert before leaving

## Confine

In the event of a chemical alert



Go to the nearest building



Seal doors, windows and air intakes



Wait for the end of the alert before leaving

## Flee or barricade yourself

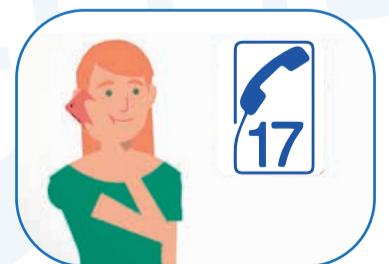
In the event of an attack



If possible, leave the premises immediately. If not, go to a building and barricade yourself in.



Turn off lights and remain in absolute silence



Alert the police on 17, 112 or 114 by SMS.
