Your registration at the university is done in two phases:

1 - ADMINISTRATIVE REGISTRATION

This is done each year and is obligatory. The calendar and registration procedures must be respected. Registrations begin on **Wednesday 8 July 2020.**

The day after your administrative registration you must validate this in your Digital Work Space (ENT)

Registrations will be done on the digital ENT between 14.00 on 20 July and midday on 24 July; and between 14.00 on 24 August, and midday on 21 September. Registrations will extend until midday on 23 October for Distance Learning (EAD) Masters 2 and University Diplomas (DU).


A UNIVERSITY WITH THREE SITES

PAUL-VALÉRY SITE (route de Mende in Montpellier) is the seat of the University. It is registered as «20th century Heritage» with an area of 10.5 hectares, it also includes the University Library, the La Vignette Theatre, the Musée des Moulages and the Students House.

SAINT-CHARLES SITE (rue du Professeur Henri Serres in Montpellier), located in the city centre, and in its heritage listed buildings (17th and 18th centuries). It houses master and doctoral courses.

THE DU-GUESCLIN CENTRE (3 allées Doyen-Nerson in Béziers) has been the Beziers branch of University Paul-Valéry Montpellier 3 since 1996. It is a real standalone campus with several multimedia rooms, a lecture theatre with 380 seats and an annexe of the University Library.

A UNIVERSITY WITH 6 FACULTIES (UFR) AND ONE INSTITUTE

Commonly known as faculties or UFR (Unité de Formation et de Recherche), they bring together several teaching departments and they work closely with different research laboratories in a disciplinary field. University Paul-Valéry has 6 UFRs and one Institute.

UFR 1: FACULTY OF HUMANITIES, ARTS, PHILOSOPHY, PSYCHOANALYSIS

Director: Corinne Saminadayar-Perrin – Deputy director: Éric Villagordo

The Faculty of Humanities, Arts, Philosophy and Psychoanalysis offers diversified teaching in the field of the Humanities: ancient languages (Greek, Latin); French and comparative literature, Philosophy, Psychoanalysis; and in the Arts: Theatre and performing arts, Cinema and audiovisual, digital arts, Music / Musicology, Plastic Arts, Dance.

Research is carried out in several research centres: IRCL (Institute for research on the Renaissance, the Classical Age and the Enlightenment), RIRRA 21 (Representing, Inventing Reality, from Romanticism to the dawn of the 21st century), CRISES (Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in Human and Social Sciences), IRIEC (Intersite Research Institute in Cultural Studies).

It has over 4,500 students enrolled in in Bachelors (Licence) courses, for professional degrees, Masters, University Diplomas (Psychotherapist, Music therapy / Music therapist, Study and practice of French speech therapy and library careers), Certificates of aptitude in ancient languages (Latin and ancient Greek) and preparations for teaching recruitment exams (preparations for the Agrégation).

UFR 2: FACULTY OF FOREIGN AND REGIONAL LANGUAGES AND CULTURES (LCER)

Director: Mme Nathalie SAGNES ALEM

The Faculty of Foreign and Regional Languages and Cultures has around 3,200 students divided between the LLCER programmes (Foreign and Regional Languages, Literatures and Cultures) and the LEA options (Applied Foreign Languages). It also provedes language teaching for specialists in other disciplines (LANSAD) and all of the students in the University.

10 languages (German, English, Arabic, Chinese, Spanish, Modern Greek, Italian, Occitan, Portuguese, Russian) are available for Bachelors (Licence) and Master degrees in LLCER and/or LEA; 2 (Catalan and Hebrew) are only available for LANSAD. This offer is complemented by university diplomas. This faculty, UFR 2, provides courses that give a strong theoretical grounding that can lead students to undertake research, as well as preparing them for integration into professional life because of the specific skills they acquire for this.

UFR 3: FACULTY OF HUMAN SCIENCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES

The Faculty of Human Sciences and Environmental Sciences has 2,800 students in both initial training and in continuing education.

It is organised in 4 departments: History, Geography-Development, History of Art and Archaeology, Biology-Ecology-Environment. With 7 first-degree courses, 1 Professional degree, 27 Masters degrees, 6 DU and 3 «Prépas» courses, it has one of the broadest selection of courses in France in Human Sciences and Environmental Sciences.

Our students follow very high standard courses in cutting-edge sectors with a high level of professional integration. They benefit from special access to the professional networks at the Faculty to facilitate their search for placements and for jobs. They enjoy working conditions that are favourable for their success as well as personalised support. The Faculty offers privileged access to a wide variety of careers including teaching and research, underpinned by 6 internationally renowned research teams, which encourages further studies up to doctoral level.

UFR 5: FACULTY OF INDIVIDUAL AND SOCIAL SCIENCES

The Faculty of Individual and Social Sciences is a teaching and research unit of University Paul-Valéry Montpellier 3 which has 3 departments: Psychology, Sociology, Ethnology, and each offers 4 first-degree courses (Psychology, Ethnology and Anthropology, Sociology, and Health and Social Sciences) 2 professional degrees (Option Press Relations and Media Relations; Option Managing health and social interventions in Gerontology), 6 Masters courses and 3 University Diplomas (Accompanying carers for professionals, Neuropsychological care for brain injuries, psychosocial risks: understanding and acting to improve the quality of life at work)

As a unit for teaching and research (UFR) the Faculty has over 3,500 students in initial and continuing education, providing high added value teaching for non-specialist students enrolled on other courses and in other units.

Classes are taught by 86 permanent teacher-researchers and over 200 professionals and outside collaborators, backed up by a team of 17 administrative and technical staff. All the personnel in the Faculty make sure that students get the best welcome and that the best human and technical conditions are available for teaching, research and the professional integration of individual and social sciences. Teaching is based on updated research carried out in the three research teams of which the teacher-researchers of UFR 5 are members. The attractiveness of this Faculty lies in the Bachelors-Masters-Doctorate route which includes programmes adapted for professional application and research, in an intercultural environment, open to international perspectives and to questions about today's society.

The Faculty has 2,500 students enrolled for Bachelors degrees (Licence), Masters and University Diplomas, as well as about 15,000 students from different transversal courses across the University, including the Béziers campus, who have classes in computing skills, mathematics, data science and teaching careers as well as sports practice. UFR 6 is made up of 4 departments: Teacher training in LLASHS, Education Sciences, Mathematics and Applied Computing and the Sports Department.

The Faculty offers high level vocational course for careers in Education Sciences and careers in teaching, Data Science or teaching in collaboration with the INSPÉ: Plastic Arts, Library Studies, Musical Education, Languages (German, English, Chinese, Spanish, Italian, Occitan), Literature (Classical and Modern), Philosophy, History-Geography, Social and Economic Sciences, Medico-Social Sciences and Techniques.

The postgraduate schools offer doctoral contracts and mobility grants and they also give support thesis defence vivas financially. They are members of the Languedoc-Roussillon doctoral college.

Sandwich courses at University Paul-Valéry Montpellier 3

All the studies have shown that a student who follows a work-linked course is better equipped to face the job market. For the student, a sandwich course means acquiring basic knowledge at the University and at the same time being trained in practical applications within a professional organisation. At University Paul-Valéry Montpellier 3, over 40 courses are organised in alternating mode.

From a legal point of view, this alternation is done using two types of work contract: the apprenticeship contract and the professionalisation contract.

WARNING!

For some transversal subjects (computing, modern languages, sport), only subjects with grades below 10 in the 1st exam can be retaken.

Regarding placement reports for Bachelor's degrees (Licence) and professional degrees Reports, there is only one exam session.

Bachelor's (Licence) students, did you get at least 40 credits (ECTS) during the university year? You may have a «Fail» but be allowed to continue (AJAC). This is only possible where two consecutive years (L1/L2 or L2/ L3) are concerned. As a priority, AJAC students should validate the grades they are missing from the previous year.

In the Masters programme there are one or two obligatory placements, introduction to research, how to write a dissertation or report and also other modules of personal work. There is only one exam session for dissertations or reports and the placements in Master 1 and Master 2.

Handicapped students must go as soon as possible to the teaching secretariat and present the definitive decision regarding special arrangements to be made for their classes or exams, as determined by the SAE-SH on advice from the preventive medicine office.



Outils Collaboratifs (collaborative tools): here you can get access to your mail and mailing lists, also to a service for sharing large files and to a tool for organising meetings

Assistance (Help): here you can make requests for help, manage your account, get ENT assistance and help with your multiservice card.

CERTIFICATES IN COMPUTING AND COMPUTER LANGUAGES (PIX)

All students in the first year (L1) of a Bachelors degree (Licence) are obliged to take a course in computer skills and computer use in order to acquire or reinforce digital skills which are useful immediately for their studies as well as for personal and professional activities. A range of options is available for second and third year students (L2 - L3) to complete this training.

These courses validate the national reference framework of digital skills.

Also, University Paul-Valéry is licensed as a «PIX certification centre» which means that the university can provide free training for national PIX certification to students in initial training.



HIGHER EDUCATION LANGUAGE SKILLS CERTIFICATION (CLES)

The CLES (Certificat de Compétences en Langues de l'Enseignement Supérieur / Higher Education Language Skills Certification) is a qualification recognised by the National Ministry of Education and is grounded in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). It certifies the level of a candidate's language skills at students, both oral and written.

This is available to all students in the University as well as outside candidates, and there are three common reference levels: CLES B1, CLES B2 and CLES C1. 5 skills are evaluated: oral comprehension, written comprehension, written production, oral production and oral interaction, depending on the CLES concerned. At University Paul-Valéry the CLES is available in 6 languages: German, English, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese and Russian.



HEALTH

The Students Service of Preventive Medicine and Promotion of Health (SUMPPS) is a space for listening and for health issues: information, prevention, orientation and health education. If you have any health question or problem, you can meet a health professional (doctor or nurse) at the SUMPPS, no appointment necessary.

Please note: this is not a healthcare centre, dispensing prescriptions.

By invitation: health check for students who have registered for the first time (these students will get an invitation for a health check visit with a nurse or doctor).

By appointment:

- Consultations nutrition:
- Consultations psychological issues;
- Consultations for sports practice authorisation;
- Consultations for special exam arrangements (extra time, specific arrangements for medical reasons, etc.);
- Consultations suitability for communal living (for accommodation in the student villages, etc.);
- Consultations grant maintenance for medical reasons;
- Workshops: stop smoking, sophrology.

HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK

REGISTERS ARE AVAILABLE

Have you been the direct witness or a victim of violence or harassment? Do you want to report security problems or comment on your work or study conditions? There are health and security registers available (Registres Santé et Sécurité au Travail - RSST) in each department or faculty in the University.

These registers record and conserve comments on events and risk situations as well as the university response to these remarks.

They are open to all the users and students in the University and they concern all the events which might be linked to work and study conditions: disrespect, violence, harassment, psychosocial risks, professional risks, improvement of working conditions.

If needed, the prevention counsellor is available to help you compose your comment.

Your remarks are strictly confidential, and will be validated, and possibly commented on by the head of the department concerned before being passed to the Hygiene, Security and Working Conditions Committee (Comité d'Hygiène, de Sécurité et des Conditions de Travail -CHSCT).
