Process	 The University of origin must nominate the student and send the documentation to movilidad@internacionales.udelar.edu.uy Once the documentation has been verified, this office will submit the application to the corresponding school. The school may or may not accept the student or make observations and/or modifications to the proposed work plan. If the application is accepted by the corresponding school, the acceptance letter will be sent. Once the student is accepted and before starting the mobility, a copy of his/her travel insurance must be submitted.

Expenses	Students will have to cover all their transport, accommodation and meals expenses. There are no scholarships for this type of mobility.	
Health insurance	It is mandatory to have health insurance, funeral assistance and repatriation that covers the entire period of the exchange. In case the student wishes to stay in the country for longer than the agreed period for their mobility, they must have an insurance that covers their entire stay in the country.	
Visa	According to their nationality, some people must apply for a visa before entering the country regardless of the period of stay in Uruguay. For most nationalities, it is not necessary to get a visa, therefore they enter with a passport or ID card (the latter only for the nationals of Mercosur countries). In these cases, once they enter the country, they can legally stay for 90 days.
